HUNT OF THE YEAR

Travis Wise returned to LWL for his fifth visit this season. (Thanks, Travis!) This year he brought the father-and-son team of Mickey and Hunter Stubbs.

Every year Travis had gotten a very nice deer, but we just hadn't been able to get him on "the big one."

This year, he decided to try early season, so his was the first hunt of the year in early October. The guides were a little nervous because conditions were really good, and the deer—especially the mature bucks—just weren't coming in.

As the group was driving into the ranch, one of the guides spotted what he thought was a buck lying in tall grass in a mesquite thicket. They broke out the binoculars and discovered not one, but two big whitetails hidden in this spot.

There happened to be an oilfield tank battery about 100 yards east of the bucks, so they backed out and managed to circle around them without disturbing them. They then stalked up to and climbed on the tank batteries, which afforded them a reasonably good line of sight.

Travis quickly shot his buck. After the shot, the second buck jumped up and hesitated just for second, and Mickey was able to bag his.



We've taken a lot of wonderful bucks in a lot of interesting ways, but never two trophies in the same session! Congrats to Travis and Mickey on having the LWL Hunt of the Year!

A WORD ABOUT MANAGEMENT

At the Lasater Whitetail Lodge, we place a lot of emphasis on managing the whitetail herd. We focus on a number of areas that affect herd quality and the all-important horn size. These include age structure of the herd, buck-to-doe ratios, nutrition and genetics.

One of the most important tools in managing the genetics is culling. And this is not just limited to shooting spikes and does, though we do a lot of that as well. We take a lot of fabulous management bucks through our hunting program. These are deer that, for their age, are not what we are striving for and want breeding. All of the bucks on this page are management bucks, and most cost either \$1000 or \$2000. For most of these hunters, it was the best deer they had ever taken!

The great news is that someone on a management hunt gets to enjoy all the same hunting experiences, amenities and guides as a guy looking for the biggest deer out there—but for much less money! And they way our pricing is structured, two friends can hunt together and one can spend \$1850 and the other \$20,000.

Keep our fun management hunts in mind for entertaining clients or introducing kids or grandkids to their first hunting experience. You'll be glad you did!

JUMP START SEASON WITH OCTOBER 8S

LWL enjoys an extended hunting season, running from October 1st through the end of February. This means you can hunt with us a full month



before the regular season begins and also use ranch permits, preserving those on your license for a later hunt.

In 2010 we are offering select weekends in October for a discounted hunt of a big, mature eight-point, along with up to three spikes or does. This two-night hunt costs a flat rate of \$2250, and you will receive the same

all-inclusive luxury as with our trophy hunts. This is a real bargain and a great way to warm up for the season.

2010 EXOTICS PRICE LIST

We are now hunting exotics on five ranches totaling well over 5000 acres, featuring an incredible 36 different species. Best of all, we are taking truly quality trophies, placing over 25 in the Record of Exotics for 2009!

Exotics basically refer to any animals "not from 'round here." Many are

natives of Africa, Europe, Asia, India and New Zealand. They are an excellent conservation story in that they have been introduced, adapted and their numbers now flourish. Blackbuck Antelope, for example, are a native of India. The largest population of them in the world is now found in Texas.

Exotics can be hunted year-round and make a great off-season hunt or family adventure. They are also a great bonus to a Whitetail hunt. The license is cheap (compared to out-of-state Whitetail), and there are trophies to fit every budget. We hunt them on foot, and they are generally a great deal of fun!

PACKAGE HUNTS

We charge a base hunt of \$850 per hunter. This covers 4 days / 3 nights and includes guide, deer tags, field dressing of game, lodging, food, drinks (including alcohol) and airport transfer to/from San Angelo, Texas. This also serves as your deposit. We then charge trophy fees as outlined below.
